Alan D. Fuller, 65, of Warren, PA, died on Sunday, November 1, 2020, as a result of injuries sustained from a plane crash in Chautauqua County, NY. Alan was a 1973 graduate of Warren Area High School and a 1992 graduate of University of Pittsburgh Bradford with a Bachelor of Science. He was an owner of Cable Communications and also worked for Loranger's. Alan was an active member of the First Church of the Nazarene.
